The Great Departure

They conclude that the larger churches are "big" because they hear from God and therefore have the answer to church growth. But "big" as man sees it is not always an indication of God's blessing or direction for a church. God told Samuel when choosing David to be King of Israel, not to look at outward appearances as men do, but to look at the heart and the motive of men before choosing". God chose David not because of his outward greatness but because of the devotion of his heart. The main reason many churches are headed down the wrong path is because they have stopped praying and seeking the face of God as a people and as a congregation. Only by spending time in His presence will we know the real motive, focus and goals of our heart. Here is the secret of growing your church for Jesus. Grow it deeper! If you dig a hole, it will automatically become wider as you dig deeper. In the same way if we seek the Holy Ghost our churches will automatically grow in numbers as we go deeper with the Lord. It is not the size of a church that matters to God but the quality or depth of Christ formed within the individual lives of that church.

Many churches have initiated new programs to help manage or encourage new church growth. The problem is that some of these programs have stop serving the people and the people are now pressured to serve the programs. Jesus said that Man was not made for the Sabbath but the Sabbath was made for man. God did not make man to be in bondage (being in a state of joyless over-commitment) to the church and it's programs but rather commanded the church to serve, edify and build up the believers. (Eph 4:11). The

programs in themselves are not bad or unscriptural. Many times the churches and their leaders will use programs that God gave someone else to do, to try to pump life into an already exhausted congregation without the Holy Spirit's permission. The result is always death. The Bible says the letter of the law kills but the Spirit gives life. Many of God's people are tired of the shallow, barren, dried up, controlling conditions of these once godly institutions and are wanting to be free. God is willing that we be free, not so much from a person or a place, but from our shallow heartedness towards Him. Pray for your leaders and church members that all would know His Power in a new and refreshing way.

The Greater Purpose of Life

The great reformer Jonathan Edwards from the 17th century said, 'People will only find their true purpose in life when they are totally satisfied in Christ alone.' Life's purpose is not about a book, a program or a philosophy. It's all about Jesus. He must become our love, our focus and our passion.
